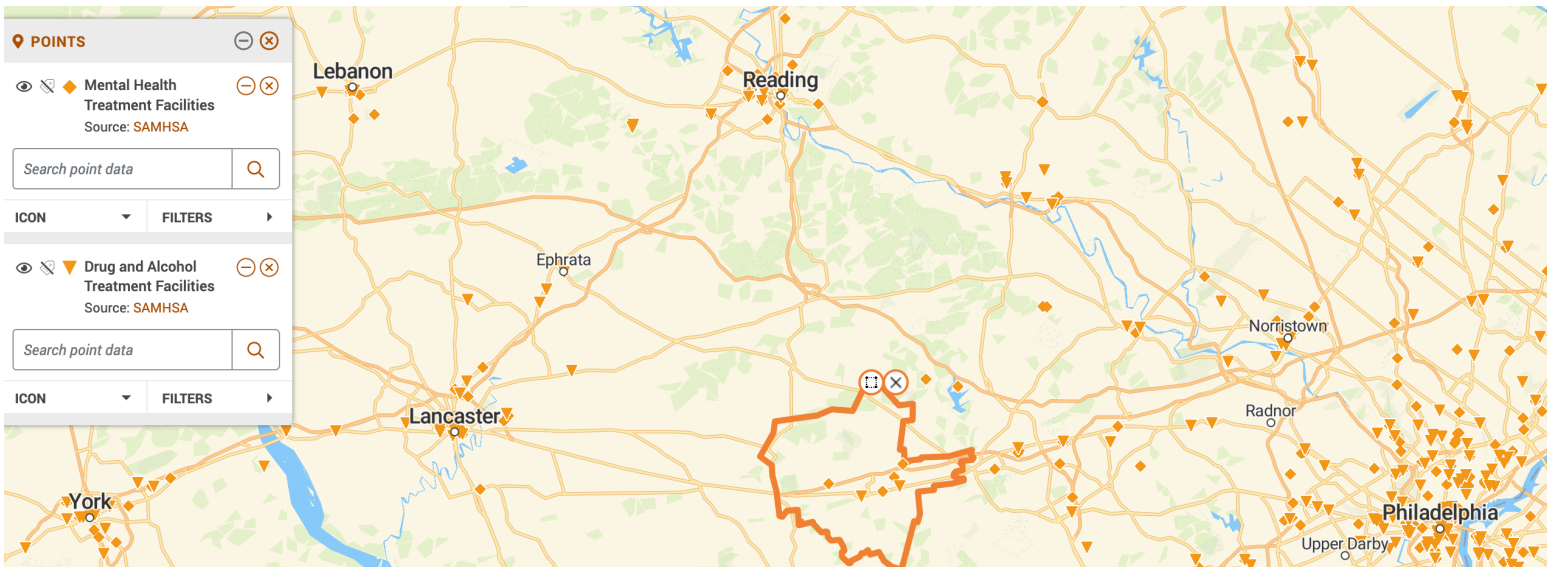


Issue Area: Behavioral Health

Mental Health and Treatment Facility Locations

Using the PolicyMap tool, mental health treatment facility locations, as well as drug and alcohol treatment facility locations are designated below.

PolicyMap downloaded the geocoded mental health and drug and alcohol treatment facilities from the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration’s (SAMHSA) Behavioral Health Treatment Services Locator, a product of SAMHSA’s Center for Behavioral Health Statistics and Quality (CBHSQ). The Locator is compiled from responses to CBHSQ’s annual surveys of treatment facilities (the National Survey of Substance Abuse Treatment Services and the National Mental Health Services Survey). Mental health treatment facility locations are designated by an orange diamond, while drug and alcohol treatment facilities are designated by an orange triangle.



In the 2022 Greater Coatesville Community Health Impact Report, respondents were asked to identify changes to the healthcare system that they think would help healthcare access:

Telemedicine with a Mental Health Professional: Focus group members with community experience indicate that a “central, private place for telehealth services would be useful.” Other focus group members support the “repurposing of community space to provide telehealth services.” Key informant interviews and focus groups indicated access to pediatric and geriatric mental health services as a recommendation and priority.

Common themes and priorities were found across the Community Survey, Key Informant Interviews, and Focus Groups discussions, showing four priorities and areas of concern. Behavioral Health Services were identified as one of the four major themes and priorities as follows:

- *Mental Health and Substance Abuse Treatment and Prevention Services*
- *Newly Designed System of behavioral health services*
- *Urgent and non-urgent services*
